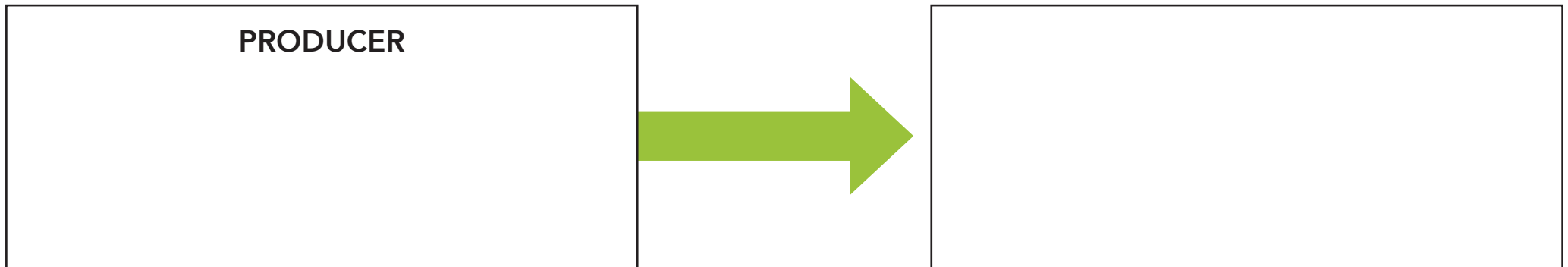

All animals are consumers as they eat (consume) their food.

Animals that scavenge on dead or dying animals are called 'Detritivores'. Can you find any on the park?

Glossary

Animal Food Chains

Carnivore	An animal who eats mostly meat.
Consumer	Animals are consumers because they consume (eat) their food for energy.
Diet	The type of food that an animal eats.
Food Chain	How energy is passed from one living thing to another.
Food Web	How items within different food chains can be linked to more food than one food chain.
Herbivore	An animal who eats only plants.
Omnivore	An animal that eats some meat and some plants.
Predator	An animal who hunts and catches other animals for food.
Prey	An animal who is hunted and caught by another animal for food.
Primary Consumer	An animal who eats plants.
Producer	Plants are producers because they produce their own food through photosynthesis.
Secondary Consumers	An animal who eats the primary consumers.
Tertiary Consumer	An animal who eats the secondary consumers.
