

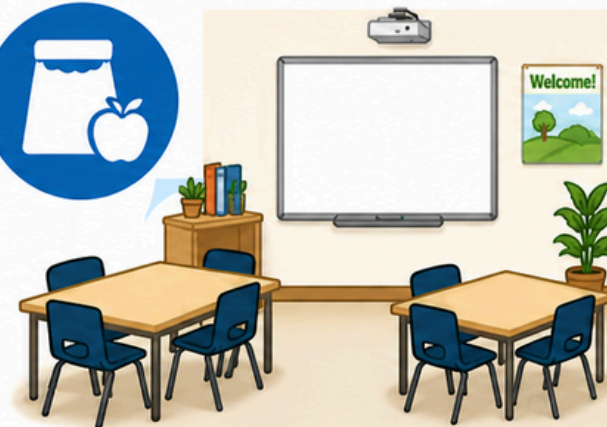
# SAMPLE SCHOOL VISIT ITINERARY

## ARRIVAL (10:00AM)

## MORNING ACTIVITIES (10:45AM – 11:45AM)

- **10:45am:** Bottle feeding. Learn how to feed lambs, goats and calves
- Learn about feeding, habitats and care
- **11am:** Goat walking. Enjoy a walk with one of our beautiful goats.
- **11:30am:** Small animal handling. Get to grips with your favourite animals



## AFTERNOON ACTIVITIES (12:30PM – 2:30PM)

- **1pm:** Hunters of the Sky flying display (subject to availability and excluding Fridays)  
See how our majestic birds fly and hunt
- **Free Deer Train Safari:** Hand feed our friendly deer and sheep up close.
- **2pm: Total Ferret Wipeout.** Cheer on your country at our international ferret race
